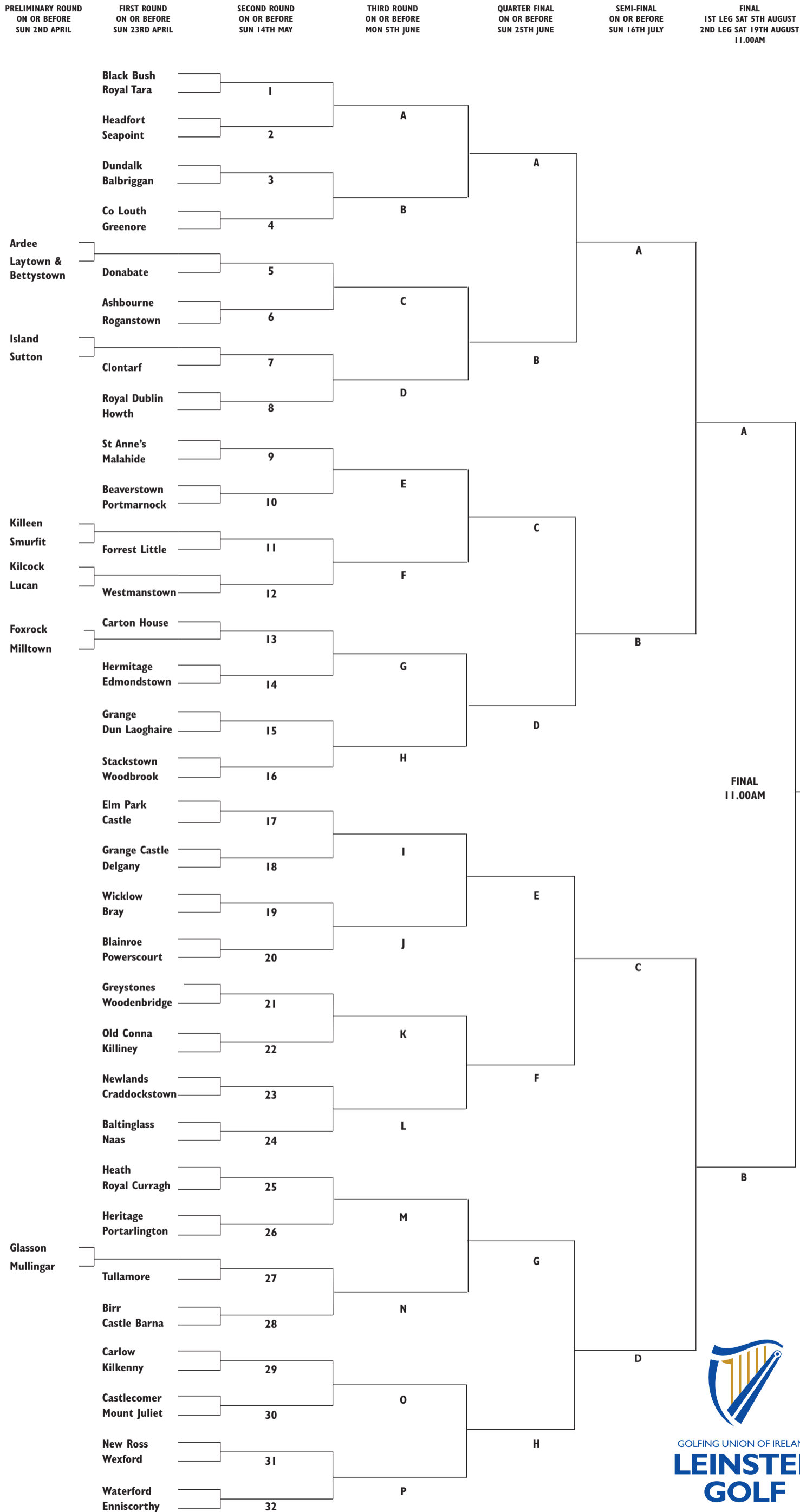

## LEINSTER UNDER 15 INTER-CLUB MATCH PLAY CONDITIONS 2017

(To be read in conjunction with Golfing Union of Ireland Tournament Conditions 2017)

For the preliminary and first round matches the Club on the top of the draw has home advantage.

For the second and subsequent rounds, up to the semi-final, the Club whose number or letter appears first will have home advantage.

For the Final the club whose letter appears first shall play at home in the first leg.

### Second Round:

### Third Round:

H-O-K-F-L-B-D-N-J-I-P-E-C-M-G-A

### Quarter-Final:

### Final:

A-B

A player who turns 15 years on or after 1st January in the year of the Tournament is eligible to compete.

No player may play for more than one club in this competition during the season.

Penalty: Disqualification of the team

In cases of doubt, eligibility shall be decided by the Leinster Provincial Council.

Each team shall consist of five members.

The format shall be singles match play with five matches played at home and five matches played away. The result of the matches shall be determined by the aggregate of matches won and each match shall be played to a finish in each leg, until an overall result has been determined.

In the event of a tie after the second leg in each round the final pairing that played in the second leg shall as soon as practicable engage in sudden death, commencing at the 19th hole, until a result is achieved.

All matches shall be played off current handicap subject to the following:

- boy under 15 years on 1st January whose handicap exceeds 14 shall play off 14.
- boy under 14 years on 1st January whose handicap exceeds 18 shall play off 18.

Teams shall be placed in order of current official handicap, with the member with the lowest handicap playing last.

Penalty for breach - Disqualification of team

The respective Team Captains (Managers) of the two teams about to engage in a match shall interchange simultaneously, thirty minutes before each match commences, the names of the members of their team which shall indicate the order of play, (see 9 above), official handicap and handicap for eligibility and date of birth of each player.

Results of matches must be reported, by the winning team, to the Leinster Golf office, preferably by e-mail, not later than the first working day after the match (each round) has been completed.

**There will be no extensions granted.** If a match is not played by the closing date both clubs will be scratched unless one of the clubs has received a walk-over.

No caddies are permitted. Penalty for Breach - Loss of Hole to a maximum of 2 holes. Any further breach will lead to the disqualification of the player.
