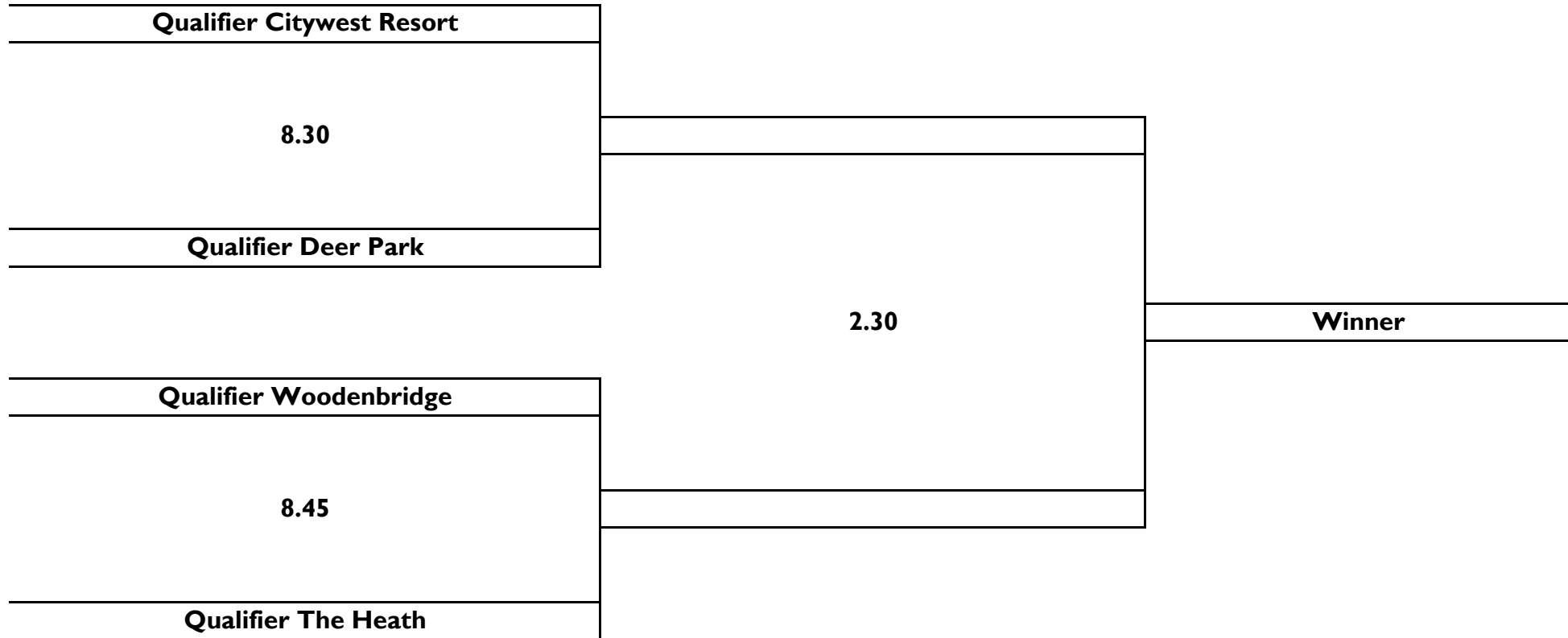

# IRISH JUNIOR FOURSOMES 2017

## CONDITIONS

**(To be read in conjunction with Golfing Union of Ireland Tournament Conditions 2017)**

- Teams consist of four male members who are under 18 years on 1st January in the year of the tournament
- A player must compete for his Home Club (defined in the CONGU UHS as the club which controls and administers his handicap) should that club require him to do so. If his Home Club does not require him to compete, a player may only compete for another club under one of the following scenarios: a) His Home Club has not entered the tournament; b) The Player receives written permission from his Home Club. If required, a copy of the written permission from his Home Club must be forwarded to the opposing Team Captain and relevant Branch Office within four days of any request.  
**Note - In Leinster - the written permission must be submitted to the Leinster Golf office at least four days in advance of the competition day or presented to the Leinster Golf official in charge on the day of the event before close of play.**
- The individual maximum handicap limit is 12 and a player with a higher handicap must play off 12. Players play off current playing handicap
- In medal play half of the combined handicap will be allowed to each pair. Half shots will apply
- In match play half of the full difference between the combined handicap of either side will apply
- Leinster Golf and its Match Officials reserve the right to alter tee-times
- Play shall be by foursomes medal play over 18 holes in the Qualifying round and by Match play thereafter. Four teams qualify for the match play stage from The Heath and Citywest Resort, and two teams to qualify from Woodenbridge and Deer Park. The outright winner at each venue will proceed to the Leinster semi-finals
- In the event of a tie in the Qualifying round, the worst of the two cards is discarded and the result determined by the best card
- If still a tie the decision shall be on the last 9, 6, 3, 2, 1. If still a tie, on the last 3, 6, 7, 8 of the first nine. If still ties the decision shall be by lot
- In the match play stages, play shall be over 18 holes and the aggregate of holes up shall decide the winning team
- In the event of a tie, the 2<sup>nd</sup> pair shall play sudden death
- No professional golfer nor any person whose age exceeds the age limit for this event may act as a caddie
