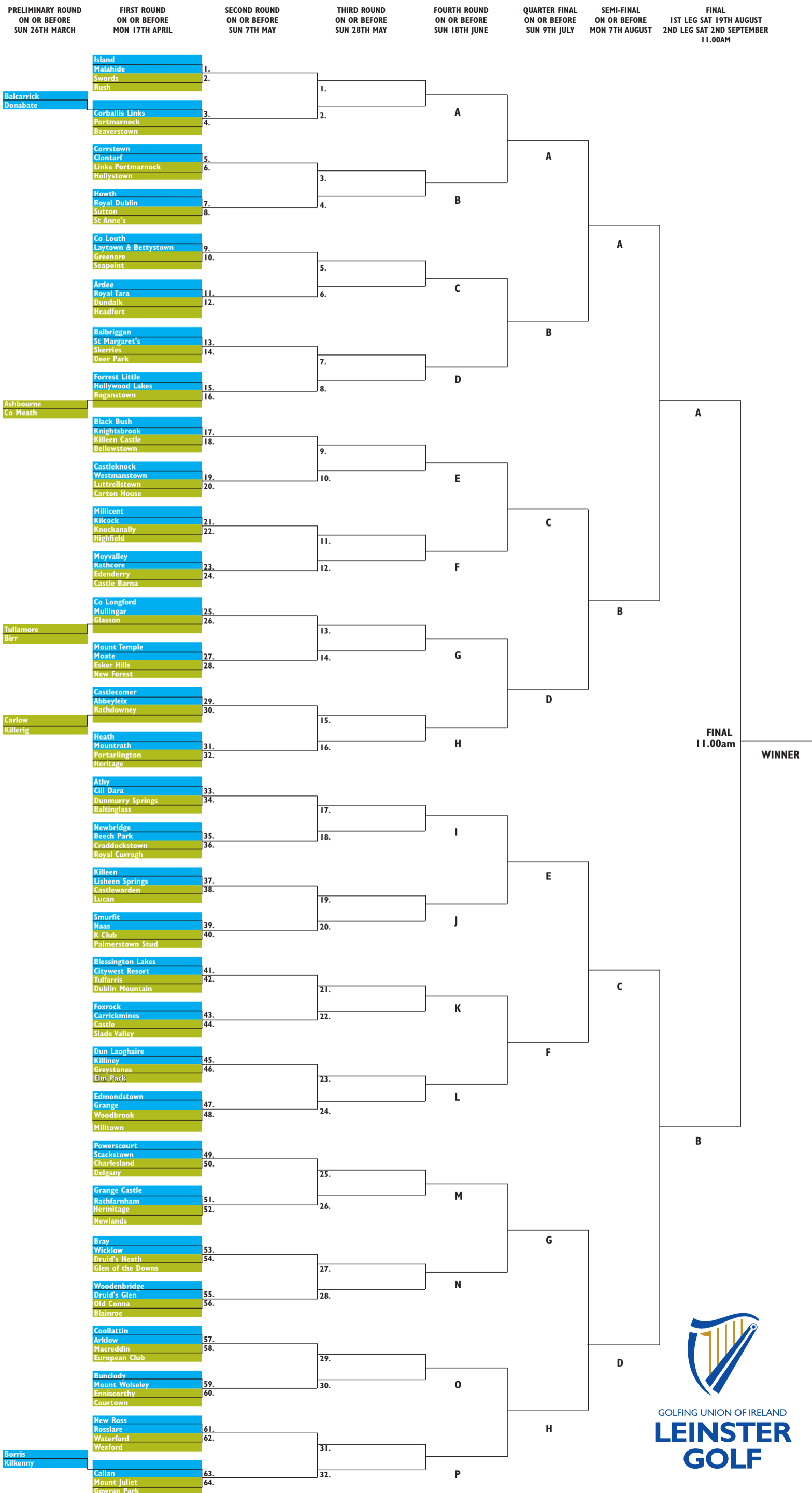

FBD Barton Cup – Conditions 2017

For the preliminary and first round matches the Club on the top of the draw has three matches at home.

For the second and subsequent rounds, up to the semi-final, the Club whose number or letter appears first will have three matches at home.

For the Final the club whose letter appears first shall play at home in the first leg.

The following Conditions should be read in conjunction with the Golfing Union of Ireland Tournament Conditions Booklet 2017:

*All matches shall be played off scratch. The combined handicap of any pair shall not be lower than 14.

*The handicap applicable shall be deemed to be the lowest handicap held by a player in the preceding calendar year.

*Competitors must have competed in at least four singles Qualifying Competitions in the previous calendar year. If a player changes his club during the previous calendar year, it is his responsibility to produce evidence of four Qualifying Competitions.

*The penalty for breaches of Rules 5, 6, 7, 11 and 12 shall be disqualification of the team concerned.

There will be no extensions granted. If a match is not played by the closing date both clubs will be scratched unless one of the clubs has received a walk-over.

All matches must be played to a finish unless an overall result has been achieved.

The winning Club should notify Leinster Golf not later than the **FIRST** working day after the match has been completed.

The Final

The final shall be played on a home and away basis and in the event of a tie after the second leg the number one pairing that have played in the second leg shall immediately play match play over three holes in such sequence as shall be prescribed by Leinster Golf before the final. If still tied shall engage in sudden death playoff over the same prescribed holes.

The use of an approved ball and conforming driver is mandatory.
